(part of the Nokiidaa Trail, links to Mabel Davis Conservation Area)

George Richardson is a 74 acre park located in north Newmarket. This park is located along the banks and floodplain of the Holland River. Mature trees and vegetation line the river trail. As well, many species of wildlife can be seen.

The Park also has extensive areas for baseball and soccer.

Access Point(s): Off Bayview Pkwy.

Main Intersection(s): Bayview Pkwy., just north of Davis Dr.

Total Approximate Distance: 3.2 km

Parking: Several different points along Bayview Pkwy.

Surface of Trail: Granular, paved
